The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case F.I.R. No. 162, dated 11.04.2017, registered under Sections 384, 389, 120-B, 420, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City Sonipat, District Sonipat.
