The present petition has been filed under Section 438 the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.97 dated 18.09.2016, registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC and Section 24 of Emigration Act at Police Station Phase XI, SAS Nagar Mohali.

An amount of Rs.2,75,000/- through three demand drafts and Rs.25,000/- in cash have been handed over to learned counsel for the complainant in the Court. Photocopies of the drafts are taken on record as Mark 'A'.

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance of the order dated 3.10.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the fact that an amount of Rs.2,75,000/- stands paid to the complainant and the petitioner has joined the investigation, the order dated 03.10.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
