JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant second petition, preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Petitioners have sought the grant of pre-arrest bail apprehending their arrest in case FIR No.249, dated 15.05.2016, under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Central, Faridabad during the pendency of the trial.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, it has been pointed out by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sunil Kumar that petitioner No.2-Ashok Madan has already been arrested and granted the interim bail by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad vide order dated October 17, 2017.

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3. In view of the submission made by learned State counsel, instant petition has rendered infructuous qua petitioner No.2-Ashok Madan and as such, same is dismissed.

4. As far as petitioner No.1 is concerned, learned counsel for the petitioners does not want to proceed with the instant petition.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner No.1-Smt.Latesh Madan.
