Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0067 dated 05.07.2017 under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act and Section 420 of IPC, registered at Police Station Abohar 2, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 18.09.2017 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Bhagwan Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 01.12.2017 and his custodial interrogation is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 18.09.2017 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
