By filing the present petition, under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No.35 dated 20.01.2016, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468 and 471, at Police Station Sector-17, Chandigarh.

It is contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the instant case. The amount has already been recovered from the petitioner. The challan stands presented. The petitioner is behind the bars since 20.01.2016.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

Heard.

The petitioner allegedly had withdrawn amount of Rs. 11,20,000/- from the account on the basis of forged documents by changing his name and identity. Moreover, he is also involved in 05 other FIRs. Therefore, keeping in view the nature of offence and the antecedents of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant the relief as prayed for.

Dismissed.
