Petitioner-Pardeep @ Billiya has filed this 4th petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.51 dated 24.02.2015, registered at Police Station Khol, District Rewari, under Sections 302, 386, 450, 34 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that first of all, no injury is attributed to the present petitioner. Neither he is named in the FIR, nor anything is

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attributed to him in the FIR. Furthermore, co-accused, Vipin, who is named in the FIR, has already been given the benefit of regular bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 30.08.2017 passed in CRM-M-30261-2017.

The petitioner has been in custody since 28.06.2015. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
