Petitioner-Tarun Minocha has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.246 dated 01.06.2017, registered at Police Station Udyog Vihar, Gurugram, under Sections 419, 420, 120-B IPC read with Section 66-D of the Information Technology (Amendment) Act, 2008 and Sections 467, 468 and 471 IPC, added subsequently.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

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I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, nine persons by giving fake identities while opening their bank accounts, formed a fake company in the name of Indiabulls Finance Limited and cheated the public persons by misusing the name of complainant's company i.e. M/s Indiabulls Housing Finance Limited, which is duly registered. The allegation against the present petitioner is that he has prepared fake and forged RBI letter. The co-accused have also named the present petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; in view of nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
