This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 25 dated 5.4.2016, under Sections 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Khuhian Sarwar, Tehsil Abohar District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in fact the matter has been compromised between the parties and pursuant to that compromise, Crl. Misc. M 21820 of 2016 was filed in which the complainant was directed to get her statement recorded regarding genuineness of the compromise, wherein she has stated that she did not want to pursue the matter, vide order dated 21.8.2017. Learned counsel argues that the statement of the complainant has been recorded.

At this stage, appearance has been caused on behalf of the complainant/respondent No.2, who admits to the factum of the compromise, while further submitting that she will have no objection in case regular bail is granted to the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the fact that the bail application is not being opposed on the ground of the compromise having been entered between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
