In compliance to the order dated 11.8.2017, the petitioner has produced an original receipt No.916987 dated 19.8.2017 showing that a sum of Rs.1500/- has been deposited with the Legal Services Committee of this Court.

It comes out from the last order that the parties have compromised the matter. Learned counsel for the complainant had stated that he has received the entire cheque amount of Rs.10,000/-. In view of the above, application stands disposed of. Main case is taken on board for hearing.

Main case

Since, the offence under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 has been lawfully compounded, judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 29.11.2006 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar and the judgment dated 23.7.2008, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar are hereby set aside and the litigation cost as per authority of Apex Court passed in Damodar S. Prabhu vs. Sayed Babalal H., 2010 (5) SCC 663 has also been deposited, therefore, petitioner stands acquitted of the notice of accusation served upon him. Bail bonds and surety bonds stands discharged.

Revision is allowed accordingly.
