Vakalatnama filed on behalf of respondents No.4 and 6 is taken on record.

This is a totally frivolous petition filed by the petitioner seeking direction to the official respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation into F.I.R. No.265 dated 11.11.2010 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 452 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, pertaining to Police Station Bhiwani Civil Lines, Bhiwani, got registered by the petitioner, in which cancellation report was filed on 21.12.2010 and thereafter, according to learned counsel for respondents No.4 to 6, the petitioner filed a criminal complaint, which is still pending adjudication and the petitioner has himself placed on record copy of order dated 03.11.2015 as Annexure-P4. The civil litigation in between the parties has been decided in favour of respondent No.4.

Considering all these facts, this petition is dismissed with costs of Rs.25,000/-, to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, Bhiwani. This exemplary cost of Rs.25,000/- has been imposed just to curb down the filing of such frivolous petitions before this Court thereby wasting precious time of this Court which could have been utilized for adjudication of some genuine cause.

A copy of this order be sent to the Member Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Bhiwani, for necessary action.
