Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect/safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Prayer has also been made for issuance of appropriate directions to respondent No.2 to take action on the representation dated 09.09.2017 (Annexure P-7) made by the petitioner against respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner confines his prayer only to the extent of protection of life and liberty of the petitioner. He states that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to consider the prayer of the petitioner regarding protection of his life and liberty.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

On asking of this Court, Mr. A.S. Dhaliwal, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, but considering the fact that the petitioner has confined his prayer to the extent of protection of his life and liberty only, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation dated 09.09.2017 (Annexure P-7) and to consider the claim of the petitioner so far as the relief of protection of his life and liberty is concerned.
