Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance of order dated 4.10.2016, the petitioner appeared before the Court below and has been released on bail. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to face the proceedings without any default.

Counsel for the State as well as respondent No. 1 have not disputed this position but counsel for the complainant/respondent No. 1 opposes the application for bail on the plea that serious allegations have been raised against the petitioner with regard to sexual assault upon respondent No. 1.

I have heard counsel for the parties, perused the paper book

with the assistance of counsel for the parties.

Counsel for respondent No. 1 has not disputed that after investigation, a cancellation report was submitted and the petitioner has been summoned in a complaint case. Custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required in the circumstances. He is ready to face the proceedings, in accordance with law. In this view of the matter, interim bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) He shall not offer any threat, promise or inducement to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing the same to the Investigating Officer/Court; and
- (ii) He shall not leave the limits of this country without prior permission of the Court.
