Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.124 dated 22.05.2003, registered under Section 15, 61, 85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala.

Petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender on 13.11.2003 (according to the Investigating Officer) and on 02.01.2004 (according to learned counsel for the petitioner). Thereafter, petitioner was involved in FIR No.08 dated 17.01.2014 under Section 15, 61, 85 of NDPS Act in which he made a disclosure statement, on the basis of which production warrant of the petitioner was obtained and he was arrested in the present case. The petitioner remained proclaimed offender

for about 11 years.

As per reply filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-I, Patiala, petitioner is also involved in two other cases.

In view of above, I do not consider this case to be fit enough to grant any indulgence for grant of regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
