Petitioner-Inderdeep Singh has filed this 2nd petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.78 dated 17.07.2016, registered at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana, under Sections 307, 326, 324, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that first petition for anticipatory bail of the petitioner was dismissed on merit by this Court vide order dated 19.09.2016 and since then, neither he has surrendered before the police, nor has joined the investigation, rather proclamation proceedings have been started against him. He is avoiding the process of law for such a long period. In the order dated 19.09.2016, it has been specifically written that the present petitioner has been stated to be armed with sword and specific

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injury has been attributed to him, which he caused with sword. It is also mentioned in the order dated 19.09.2016 that sword is yet to be recovered and custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the facts that since for the last about one year after dismissal of the bail petition of the petitioner, he is avoiding his arrest; that proclamation proceedings have already been initiated him and that he is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
