The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.66 dated 24.04.2016 initial registered under Section 392 IPC and then Section 392 was substituted with Sections 395 & 120-B IPC & Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Haibowal, District Ludhiana.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was arrested on 26.04.2016 and since then he is in custody. Admittedly, the challan has been filed.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, makes statement that there is no other case pending against the petitioner.

Looking to the nature of the allegations and the amount involved in the day light robbery and the fact that the trial will take its own time, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence I make the following order:

ORDER

(i) CRL. MISC. No.M-3480 OF 2017 is allowed.

- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
- (iii) The petitioner shall not temper or influence the prosecution witness(es).
- (iv) In case of violation of the above condition, the present order shall come to an end and the petitioner shall surrender to the judicial custody.
