Nobody has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner despite service.

This writ petition was filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to make the payment of pensionary benefits, gratuity, leave encashment, provident fund etc. with interest. The writ petition was admitted on 14.9.2007 by passing the following order:
