Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. The petitioners seeks quashing of FIR No.47 dated 11.5.2015, under Sections 326, 324, 34 IPC, PS Sadar, District SBS Nagar on the basis of compounding/compromise. Pursuant to the order dated 29.11.2016, report of the learned JMIC, SBS Nagar has been received who has recorded the statements of the parties and reported that the compromise has been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion. In that view of the matter, the petition is allowed and the impugned FIR, along with all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/ compromise subject to costs of Rs.10,000/- payable to the State of Punjab through Deputy Commissioner, SBS Nagar.
