The learned counsel for the petitioner states that private respondents No. 5 to 9 trespassed in the house of petitioner and committed theft. He has matrimonial dispute with his wife, namely, Kulwinder Kaur (respondent No. 9). The occurrence was recorded in the CCTV footage.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to respondents, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ropar (respondent No. 2) to look into the complaints dated 20.7.2017 and 5.9.2017 (Annexures-P-2 and P-3 respectively) of the petitioner in accordance with law and if truth is found with abovesaid complaints, take necessary action in accordance with law, without being influenced by the fact that the petitioner had approached this Court. This order will not be taken to be direction to register FIR.
