Petitioner-Balkar Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.73 dated 14.06.2015, registered at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur, under Sections 302, 323 and 120-B IPC and Sections 307 and 380 IPC added later on.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and the complainant also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner; learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegation of prosecution, three persons committed the murder of second wife of complainant-Piara Singh. The present petitioner is alleged to be close relative of Gurnam Singh, son of the complainant. As per the prosecution version, the present petitioner in connivance with Gurnam Singh got engaged some persons, who murdered the second wife of the complainant.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of serious allegations levelled against the present petitioner, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
