Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 257 dated 2.8.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 186, 332, 353 IPC, registered at Police Station Nangal Chaudhary.

A perusal of the FIR shows that one Ashok Kumar who was posted as Junior Engineer in DHBVN, Sub Division, Nangal Chaudhary was on his official duty for checking the theft of electricity and during the search it was found that the petitioner-Sarpanch himself was involved in the commission of theft and when the complainant- Ashok Kumar clicked a photograph from his phone and made entry in LL-1 book, petitioner raised a voice and collected many people of the village including women and gave beatings to the complainant -Ashok Kumar; snatched his mobile phone and LL-1 book on which the complainant -Ashok Kumar had made entries. As per the MLR, complainant-

Ashok Kumar sustained four injuries.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has given beatings to a government servant while discharging his official duty, no case is made out for granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
