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**TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J**

The instant petition was preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.16, dated 30.01.2016, under Sections 420/193/199/200/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala on the basis of compromise which as per counsel had been entered into between the parties.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 05.10.2016:

*“Quashing of FIR has been prayed for on the basis of compromise.*

*Notice of motion for 15.12.2016.*

*Meanwhile, the complainant/ victim may approach the investigating officer to voluntarily offer any supplementary statement. It will be open to the investigating agency, on the basis of the said supplementary statement, to form an opinion regarding presentation of cancellation report.”*

Thereafter, when the matter came up for hearing on 17.01.2017, learned State counsel had submitted that a supplementary statement of the

complainant had been recorded and in the light thereof the cancellation report is under process but the same has not been submitted.

During the course of hearing today, learned State counsel, who is on instructions from ASI Santokh Singh makes a statement at the bar that the cancellation report has been submitted in the Court of competent jurisdiction.

In the light of such circumstances, nothing would survive in the instant petition and the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

It is, however, made clear that in the eventuality of the complainant objecting to the acceptance of cancellation report, all pleas that may be available to the accused/present petitioners would be available in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
