Heard learned counsel for the rival parties. The petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR NO.46 dated 23.4.2017, registered under Sections 15/25/59 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Police Station Sadar Nawanshahr, District SBS Nagar. According to the prosecution, the petitioner along with his co-accused was apprehended having 60 kilograms of poppy husk in their possession contained in two bags. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the said recovery of contraband from two persons falls within the category of non commercial quantity. Counsel for the State on instructions states that there is no other case against the petitioner. In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned on furnishing undertaking that he will not indulge in such offence in future.
