The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 61, dated 19.05.2017, under Sections 379-B/323 IPC, registered at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he along with other accused had taken away Rs.4500/-, 09 boxes of engine oil and 02 mobile phones from the Salesman of the petrol pump. They had also allegedly filled up their motorcycle with petrol. He further contends that recovery of 09 boxes of engine oil of 01 litre each is allegedly effected from the petitioner. He also states that the petitioner is in custody for over 03 months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Amandeep Singh, states that the investigation has been completed and the challan has been filed in competent Court.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for over 03 months and investigation having been completed, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Raminder Singh @ Meter is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
