Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.24 dated 25.03.2017, under Sections 22, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been arrested on 25.03.2017 and is in jail since then.

Upon instructions from ASI Ram Singh, learned counsel for the State submits that there are two more cases are pending under NDPS Act against the petitioner, but the quantity that was seized from the petitioner is on lower side.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would file an undertaking to the trial Court. Petitioner is a woman entitled to the benefit of Section 437 Cr.P.C.

Trial will take its own time.

In that view of the matter, this petitioner be released on bail,

subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The **CRM-M-34959 of 2017** is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner shall report to the concerned Police Station on every Sunday, Monday and Wednesday between 11 am to 4 pm. The police shall keep surveillance on the petitioner.
- (iv) The petitioner to surrender her passport with the trial Court, if she possesses the same.
- (v) The petitioner would file an undertaking to the trial Court.
- (vi) Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
- (vii) In case, the petitioner violates the above said conditions, this order of bail comes to an end automatically without reference to this Court.
