ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.110 dated 03.11.2010 under Sections 323/324/34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Panjokhra, District Ambala (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise dated 09.05.2017 (Annexure P-3) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that FIR is outcome of minor differences between the residents of same locality and the injuries are on non-vital parts of the body of complainant. The matter has now been compromised.

This Court by the order dated 19.09.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ambala, has sent

her report dated 29.09.2017, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of minor differences between the residents of same locality and the injuries are on non-vital parts of the body of complainant. The matter has now been compromised.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.110 dated 03.11.2010 under Sections 323/324/34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Panjokhra, District Ambala and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
