JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

By way of petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.101, dated 17.09.2015, registered under Sections 307, 365, 341 and 148 of the Indian Penal Code (for the 'the IPC') read with Section 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran.

The learned counsel for the petitioners refers to FIR to contend that no specific roles and injuries have been attributed to the petitioners. Petitioners have been falsely implicated in the instant case.

On the other hand, the learned counsel for the complainant states that on the incitement of the petitioners cousin of the complainant, namely, Dhanvir was abducted. Subsequent thereto a gun fire injury was caused to him by co-accused, Dilbag Singh, husband of petitioner No.1 resulting into amputation of right leg of injured-Dhanvir.

The learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the assertion raised by the learned counsel for the petitioners and prayed for dismissal of the present petition.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and carefully perused the entire record on file.

Though no specific injuries are attributed to the petitioners, however, their presence and active participation are specifically come on record. Therefore, in view of the serious nature of injury; gravity of the offence and the weapons used in the crime, no case for bail is made out.

Dismissed.
