Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Som Nath alias Dholi in case registered by way of FIR No.22 dated 16.01.2015 at Police Station City Kapurthala under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh from Police Station City Kapurthala submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 20.09.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been released on bail.

In view of what has been stated above and since none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner, in the light of orders passed

earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 20.09.2017 is made absolute.
