Petitioner-Rajat Rana has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.117 dated 11.07.2017, registered at Police Station Garshankar, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 324, 323, 341 and 34 of IPC and Section 326 of IPC added later on.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is a case of version and cross-version and the petitioner has himself suffered five injuries on his person. He further submits that grievous injury suffered by the injured is on the finger of the hand.

Learned State counsel submits that sword has already been recovered.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 20.09.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 20.09.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
