The petitioners have approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty on the premise that petitioner No.1 has performed marriage with petitioner No.2 against the wishes of her parents and other family members and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at their instance.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3 – State.

The petitioners have submitted that a representation dated 15.09.2017 was made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala (Annexure P-4) seeking necessary protection but no action has been taken so far in the matter.

Heard.

Without examining the question of validity or otherwise of marriage of the petitioners, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala to look into grievance of the petitioners expressed in the representation dated 15.09.2017(Annexure P-4) and take appropriate action, if any, warranted in the circumstances.
