By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought regular bail in case bearing FIR No.677, dated 29.08.2017 registered under Sections 342, 406, 506 and 34 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Palwal District Palwal.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that during the investigation of the case, nothing incriminating has been recovered from him and this fact has not been disputed by learned State counsel. It is further contended that the petitioner is in custody since 29.08.2017 and no recovery is to be effected from him.

There is no allegation that petitioner is likely to threat any prosecution witnesses or his custodial interrogation is required.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Palwal.
