ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.127 dated 24.07.2015, under Sections 382/323/506/148/149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he along with others had beaten up the complainant. He further contends that even as per the contents of FIR, the petitioner was unarmed and only fist blows are stated to have been inflicted upon the complainant, who has received two injuries which are simple in nature.

This Court, by the order dated 20.09.2017, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting

Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhjinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 20.09.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
