The petitioners have prayed for quashing of FIR No.55 dated 15.09.2015, for offence under Sections 324, 341, 354, 34 of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') registered in Police Station S.G.N. Dev Thermal, District Bathinda on the basis of compromise dated 07.10.2015 (Annexure P2) effected between the parties.

In the present case, the FIR was registered at the instance of Gurpreet Singh son of Jagtar Singh. Now, dispute between the parties has been resolved by way of compromise (Annexure P2).

Vide order dated 03.11.2016, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded with regard to genuineness of compromise.

Pursuant thereto, a report has been submitted by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bathinda, wherein it has been reported

Counsel for the State has not disputed that the parties i.e. petitioners and respondents have arrived at a settlement with an intent to give burial to their differences.

In view of what has been discussed hereinabove, the petition is allowed and FIR No.55 dated 15.09.2015, for offence under Sections 324, 341, 354, 34 IPC registered in Police Station S.G.N. Dev Thermal, District Bathinda and proceedings emanating therefrom are ordered to be quashed, *qua* the petitioners.
