Petitioner-Bhupender has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.372 dated 22.09.2016, registered at Police Station Pataudi, under Sections 395, 397 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, complainant-Mam Chand, who was going on his motor-cycle, was hit with lathi blow. When he fell down, two-three more persons came there and lifted him to

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the road side fields and snatched his mobiles. They also took away his motor-cycle and cash from the purse.

The case is at preliminary stage. No witness has been examined so far. There is every chance of tampering with the evidence by the petitioner, if he is released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail at this stage.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
