The petitioner, who is the son-in-law of the complainant/ respondent No. 2, seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 38 dated 07.06.2016 registered under Sections 498-A, 406,34 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' for short) at Police Station Kabarwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner and the complainant inform the the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. A petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 shall be filed by the petitioner and the complainant's daughter, Navdeep Kaur on 10.03.2017, as stated before the Pre Lok Adalat at Sri Muktsar Sahib.

As per report received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the above said facts are reiterated. Copy of the order dated 06.02.2017 passed by the learned District Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib as well as the statements suffered by the petitioner and the complainant's daughter, Navdeep Kaur have been appended along with the report.

Learned counsel for the complainant/respondent No.2 submits that in these circumstances, there is no objection to the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Rashpal Singh informs that the petitioner has since joined investigation. The factum of the settlement between the parties is also affirmed by the learned counsel for the State.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequently, order dated 17.10.2016 is made absolute.
