ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.144 dated 07.10.2016, under Sections 420, 465, 466, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.4, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the only allegation against the petitioner is that he is using one sim card belonging to one Gurminder Singh and the FIR has been lodged at the behest of DIG Crime, Punjab Vigilance Bureau. He further contends that there is no allegation that petitioner is involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 06.10.2017, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2)

Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Amarjit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 06.10.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
