The present petition has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No.50 dated 10.11.2016 registered at Police Station Ghanie-Ke-Bangar, District Batala for offence punishable under Sections 363, 366 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (in short 'IPC').

Counsel for the petitioner states that the alleged kidnapped girl was major at the time of alleged occurrence. She has performed marriage with the petitioner and is residing in her matrimonial home with the petitioner. It has been apprised to the Court that statement of the alleged victim is yet to be recorded by the Investigating Officer.

In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction that the alleged victim shall appear before the Investigating Officer and record her statement with regard to her side of the story. The Investigating Officer would record her statement as per version given by the girl who would also furnish an affidavit before the Investigating Officer.
