This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of bail in case FIR No.66 dated 17.05.2017 registered under Sections 498-A, 323 and 307 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Fazilka.

Vide order dated 10.11.2017, the petitioner was directed to pay Rs.25,000/- towards costs of litigation but the same has not been done.

Learned State counsel submits that as many as seven injuries were noticed on the person of the wife/complainant.

Heard.

As per the FIR, there are specific allegations and in view of the MLR which reflects seven injuries including injury No.3 which has been declared dangerous to life, this Court feels that no case for grant of concession of anticipatory bail is made out at this stage.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.
