Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.87 dated 21.06.2017 under Section 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the allegation against the present petitioner is that along with his co-accused Gurpreet Singh had snatched purse of the complainant containing currency notes with Rs.250/- More so, the number of the motor-cycle was not disclosed on the same date. The petitioner is in custody since 31.06.2017 and decision of the case still to take some more time. So he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel contended that on basis of investigation, the father of the petitioner, namely, Satar Khan was found owner of the vehicle and no case is made out to release the petitioner and he does not deserves the concession of bail.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that primarily the allegation is regarding snatching the purse of the complainant containing currency notes with Rs.250/-, more so, the petitioner is in custody since 31.06.2017; the decision of the case still to take some more time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody and, therefore, he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Area Magistrate, SAS Nagar (Mohali).

The petition stands allowed.
