At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a direction may be given to respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib for redressal of his grievance.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib to look into the grievance of the petitioner and disposed of the same within a period of 8 weeks' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
