The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.231 dated 10.10.2015 under Sections 452/325/326/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar (Rural), along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 11.09.2017, arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is an outcome of a sudden fight between the parties and all the injured have fully recovered.

This Court by the order dated 09.11.2017, had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, has

sent her report dated 02.12.2017, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of sudden fight between the parties which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and cross case recorded vide Rapat/General Diary No.18 dated 28.10.2015 under Sections 323/324/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar (Rural) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
