For the reasons stated in the application, same is allowed and document Annexure P-4 i.e. report under Section 173 Cr. P.C. is taken on record.

CRM-M-35262-2017

This is a petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 83 dated 18.6.2017 under Sections 307, 392, 120-B IPC, registered at P.S. Mataur, District Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in judicial custody since 27.6.2017 and as per the report submitted by the police under Section 173 Cr. P.C., there are no direct allegations against the petitioner with regard to causing injuries to Tilak Raj and on the disclosure statement of co-accused Harmanjot Singh, petitioner was involved in the present case.

It is further submitted that one of the co-accused i.e. Ajay Thakur has been granted concession of bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, Mohali vide order dated 29.7.2017 and the other co-accused i.e., Anuj Jagga has been granted

concession of regular bail vide order dated 4.8.2017 passed in **CRM-M-27728-2017, Anuj Jagga vs. State of Punjab** by this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner is a student aged 20 years and his academic career will be affected in case he is not granted concession of bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surjeet Singh, submits that petitioner is not involved in any other case and has not disputed the custody undergone by the petitioner i.e. about 4 months.

Keeping in view that aforesaid facts, specially in view of the fact that the petitioner who was named by his co-accused is a student and has to pursue his studies, without commenting upon merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, SBS Nagar, Mohali.

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail in case the petitioner is found involved in any other subsequent case or found misusing concession of bail.
