SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in complaint case bearing No. COMA 44993/2013 dated 21.8.2012 under Section 18(c) read with Rule 62 punishable under Section 27 (b) (ii) and 18A read with Section 28 of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and Rules 1945 pending before the learned Sessions Court at Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that earlier the petitioner was admitted to bail in this case and had been regularly appearing in the Court except on 8.8.2017. On that day, the petitioner was not feeling well and could not inform the Court about his non appearance. Otherwise, there was no reason for the petitioner not to appear before the Court.

Learned State counsel has not disputed this fact.

Having considered the above facts that the petitioner was earlier admitted to bail in this case and his bail was cancelled on account of his non appearance before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana

on 8.8.2017, the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail on his furnishing fresh bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Judge.

However, the trial Judge shall be at liberty to complete the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed of.
