The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.21 dated 08.07.2016 registered under Sections 498-A, 406,IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Ferozepur.

Learned State counsel submits on instruction from ASI Surjit Singh that 20 tolas of gold is yet to be recovered from the petitioner. Bills of the jewellery has been given to the Investigating Officer and statement of jeweller has been recorded. Even, Rs.3,00,000/- cash has been taken by the family members of the petitioner from the complainant for the purpose of purchasing a car which has been deposited by the parents of the complainant in her account.

Complainant present in Court as identified by ASI Surjit Singh and she is ready for amicable settlement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is not ready to pay any amount for full and final settlement and even the litigation expenses.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner and the present petition is dismissed, as such.
