This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.210 dated 20.09.2016 under sections 7/10/55 of Essential Commodities Act and Sections 406, 420, 120-B I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Jakhal District Fatehabad.

On the previous date of hearing i.e. 07.10.2016 notice of motion was issued and the petitioner while being granted *ad interim* protection as regards arrest was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from S.I. Om Parkash apprises the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

Suffice it to notice that the FIR had been registered on the basis of a secret information and whereby one Maruti 800 car had been apprehended carrying 3 bags of wheat and the owner of the car namely Ajay Kumar had been apprehended on the spot. The present petitioner is sought to be implicated on the statement of co-accused Ajay Kumar and who had alleged that he had got the wheat from the present petitioner, who happens to be a Depot Holder and to be sold in the open market.

In the considered view of this Court, custodial interrogation of the petitioner, as such, would not be warranted. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 07.10.2016, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
