Counsel for the petitioner states that matrimonial dispute between the parties has been settled by way of compromise and in pursuance thereof the parties are residing together as husband and wife. It is further submitted that the trial culminated in judgment of conviction passed by the trial Magistrate but the appeal is pending before the Court of Sessions. He further submitted that as the petition does not make reference to the factum of conviction and quashing of the judgment, the petition may be dismissed as withdrawn without prejudice to rights of the petitioner to file a fresh petition with better particulars.
