The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.13 dated 5th March, 2017, registered under Sections 307, 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur.

2. It transpires that evidence of the complainant has already been recorded in the Ld. Trial Court.

3. It is further verified from the original FIR that the injury imputed to the petitioner was inflicted on the left leg of the victim- Pal Singh, certainly which was capable of causing grievous hurt,

not yet constituting the offence under Section 326 of the IPC can be imputed.

4. Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he may at this stage be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
