Photographs of marriage have been produced in Court today and same are taken on record.

Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 8.6.2017. The certificate of the marriage has been placed on file as Annexure-P-3. The true photocopies of Passport, issued by Republic of India, Birth Certificate, issued by Municipal Corporation, New Delhi, alongwith Secondary Examination Certificate, showing the date of birth of petitioner No. 1, have been placed on file as Annexures-P-1 and P-2 respectively.

In these circumstances, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to appear before Superintendent of Police, Panipat-respondent No. 2 with a representation, who shall assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that

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there is danger to the life of the petitioners, Superintendent of Police, Panipat-respondent No. 2 shall take necessary steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. However, this order shall not be construed as a recognition of valid marriage between the parties.

Disposed of accordingly.
