Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members and for fair and impartial investigation in case bearing FIR No.0091 dated 25.07.2016, under Sections 302, 307, 447, 506, 511, 120-B, 148, 149 of IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Dehlon, District Ludhiana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that respondents No.4 to 8 are roaming freely and they along with respondent No.9 are threatening the petitioner and his family members with dire consequences, in case, they failed to withdraw the aforesaid case. Even threatening calls on the mobile phone were also made to the petitioner by respondent No.4.

The petitioner has made various representations to the police seeking

protection of his life and liberty and his family members, but no action was taken. Shardha Bansal, complainant of FIR Annexure P-1 has already submitted a detailed representation to Director General of Police Punjab on 18.09.2016 (Annexure P-6), which remains unattended.

3. In view of the above, Director General of Police, Punjab, is directed to look into the representation dated 18.09.2016 (Annexure P/6) and take required action, if any, in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible and is directed to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members.

4. With the aforesaid observations made and direction issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
