The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.140 dated 13.06.2013 registered under Sections 409, 418, 420, 120-B IPC (Sections 467, 468, 471 and 201 IPC added later on) at Police Station Tarori, District Karnal.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was arrested on 16.13.2015 and is in jail since then. The offences are triable by Magistrate.

Learned State counsel submits that the samples of signatures of the petitioner were obtained during investigation but the report of the handwriting expert is still awaited. She further submits that large number of witnesses have already been examined.

Looking to the fact that the witnesses have been examined and further that there is no likelihood of tempering with the evidence and further looking to the period of detention of the petitioner since 16.03.2017 and the

trial will take its own time for disposal, I think the petitioner is entitled to concession of bail.

In that view of the matter, the petition for bail is allowed.

Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
