ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 1, dated 01.01.2017, under Sections 392, 379-A & 395 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Ladwa, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he along with other accused had snatched motor-cycle, purse and mobile phone of the complainant and a sum of Rs.800/- was allegedly recovered from the petitioner while the motor-cycle and mobile phone were recovered from the other accused. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody since 03.05.2017 and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Baljit Singh, states that investigation has been completed and challan has been filed before the competent court on 27.07.2017.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that petitioner has been in custody for over 04 months, investigation having been completed and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Shahnawaj is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds/adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
